Nancy Gallini is a Professor of Economics and currently serves as Chair of the Department of Economics at the University of Toronto. She received her Ph.D. from the University of California at Berkeley in 1980 and has held visiting positions at the University of California, Berkeley, Yale Law School and the Centre pour le Recherche en Economique and Statistique in Paris, France. She has written numerous articles on subjects of resource economics, technology licensing, competition policy and the economics of intellectual property and has served on the editorial boards of the American Economic Review, the International Journal of Industrial Organization and the Journal of Industrial Economics. Currently, she is on the editorial board of the Journal of Economic Literature. She co-edited the Industry Canada Research Series volume with Robert Anderson: Competition Policy and Intellectual Property Rights in the Knowledge-Based Economy and has served as an academic advisor to the Competition Bureau on a variety of projects.
